Invoices:

School fees cover tuition and are invoiced termly, payable in advance¹.

Payment can be made by one of these means:

- **termly**, paid on or before the first day of each term.
- **monthly**, paid in twelve (12) instalments by **Direct Debit** in advance starting from 20th August annually, and continuing on 20th monthly.
- **annually**, paid as a single payment on or before the first day at the start of each academic year.

When new pupils start during an academic year, in the Primary School and in some Secondary School year groups, fees will fall due on or before each pupil's start date as arranged with the Bursar.

Please note that if a parent or guardian chooses to withdraw their child or children, the School requires notice of a full school term. The notice should be addressed to the Headteacher in writing.

¹ *in advance, that is, School Fees paid in advance – Under Financial Conduct Authority FCA (formerly FSA) regulations, The King's School is not permitted to issue credit. It may however take payments in no more than four (4) instalments over a quarter/four-month period, **only if payments are made in advance** of the service being offered. Hence this School's stipulation is 12 payments on the 20th monthly.
