The King's School is a warm and friendly environment, with small class sizes, offering you the opportunity to enjoy teaching and develop your skills, all in a beautiful, rural setting. We have a passionate staff team, who work together to create a learning space for our pupils that challenges and inspires, whilst providing outstanding pastoral care. As teachers in a Christian school, we are able to encourage our pupils in their journey of faith and model a relationship with Jesus that is real and relevant. As teacher of Maths, you will work alongside our Head of Maths in delivering the GCSE Maths curriculum to Years 9-11. At this age, we split the class into two sets, and you would teach one of the sets in two or three of the year groups, depending on availability and need. Classes have 4 lessons per week, so this would amount to 8 or 12 lessons in total, amounting to 0.33/0.5 FTE. This would be spread over three or four days. A scheme of work is in place, and you will have the opportunity to shape the Maths curriculum as you grow into the role, ensuring that our pupils have a broad and dynamic learning experience, preparing them well for the GCSE exams at the end.

The King's School has its own pay scale, with contributions to an employer's pension scheme and healthcare cover available to all staff.
